

Assignment Example

Project #9: Shot Recreation:

Students will select a sequence from a film or tv show of their choice and present it in class along with their plan to recreate it (lighting plan).

Students will then recreate the shot(s) outside of class, presenting their finished shot(s) in class, along side the original content.

Final Shots should be color graded with presentations including a graded and ungraded version.

Students are required to keep notes on how they achieve their image.

Notes to include:

- Shooting Stop(s)
- Incident Meter Reading(s)
- Color Balance
- ISO
- Shutter Speed
- Focal Length
- Photograph(s) of each lighting Set-Up with Lights labeled
- Lighting Fixtures used
 - Any modifications to the lighting fixture (gels, diffusion, dimmer, etc...)

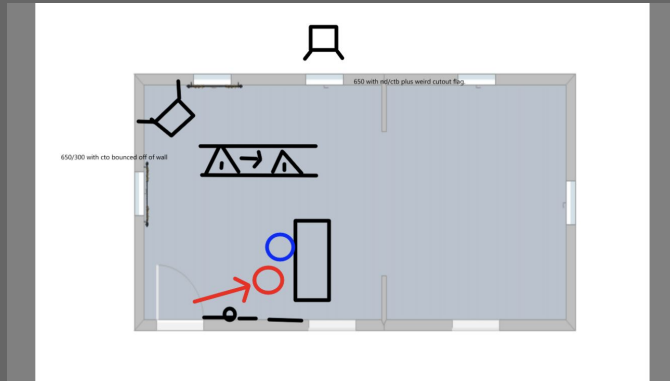

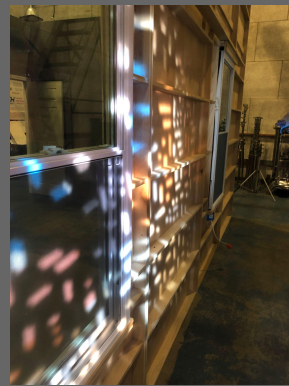
Lighting Diagram
